What is the Department of Energy Human Subjects Research Database (HSRD)?

The Human Subjects Research Database contains information on all Department of Energy (DOE) research projects involving human subjects that:

- Are funded by DOE
- Are conducted in DOE facilities
- Are performed by DOE personnel
- Include current or former DOE or contract personnel



Searches that can be performed on several different criteria within the HSRD report:

- Fiscal Year
- Research Organization
- Keyword
- Research Type
- International Projects
- Former Worker
- Medical Screening Programs

What kinds of information are available from the HSRD website?

- Cumulative site information
- Information about individual projects
- Number of subjects
- Funding information
- Total number of projects
- Project reports from each site ranging from 1995 through 2011
